BELOW IS A LIST OF CRITICAL AND CREATIVE THINKING TOOLS (and when to use them) TO HELP YOU DEVELOP YOUR CONCEPT. ASK YOUR TEACHER FOR A BLANK COPY OF ANY OR ALL OF THESE TOOLS:

- Frayer Model use to explore chosen concept
- Starburst Diagram use to develop questions around a concept or possible product
- Parnes Model use to develop a question once topics are brainstormed
- SWOT use to evaluate question
- Issues map use to brainstorm aspects of a topic to investigate possible areas of problematic knowledge
- Extended brainstorming use to synthesise preliminary research to develop areas of focus
- Word Spill use to brainstorm as many words as possible about topic
 of interest to promote ideas
- If...Then use to decide between two questions or concepts (p. 50)
- T-Chart use to compare two questions
- Y-Chart use to explore concepts/issues
- Futures Line use to decide between two questions/concepts
